



American Brewery Redevelopment Project Tour

Bill Reed, an IU alumnus, is currently the Project Director for the American Brewery Redevelopment Project in East Baltimore. Now in its final stages of conversion into retail and community services, Mr. Reed offered IU this special tour of the 121 year old former brew-house building to view the \$22 million dollar revitalization of the 60,000 sq ft building.

The American Brewery site is the original John F. Wiessner Brewery Founded in 1863. The brewhouse building was constructed in 1886 and is the most significant Norman- Gothic style building in the region and designated an historical landmark by the Nation Park Service.



Struever Brothers Eccles and Rouse is undertaking a complete historical restoration of the masonry and stone façade, monumental wood windows, elaborate ornamental metal and slate roofing and interior restorations. The interior structure of the building is being repaired and restored to accommodate the office use and corporate headquarters of Humanim, Inc, a non-profit health service and special needs provide.
